Christina Wise is a producer who graduated from Chapman University's Dodge College of Film and Television with an emphasis in Broadcast Journalism and a minor in Public Relations. Upon graduating, Christina began her career in live sports, traveling to either Las Vegas or Tijuana to produce a boxing show for ESPN Deportes.

She then took that experience to producing live Red Carpet shows with Joan and Melissa Rivers for TV Guide Network. She was at the TV Guide Network for eight years, working in various positions. She became a Show Producer and worked on series such as "Big Movie Premiere," "Count it Down," "On Set" and did many one-time specials, including biographies of celebrities. During this time, Christina also produced a travel show for PBS SoCal titled "ESCAPESEEKER," giving her the opportunity to travel and film at the greatest luxury properties in the world. After she left TV Guide, Christina produced awards programming for POPSUGAR.com and was the executive producer for its 2015 Oscar show. That same year Christina became a member of the Producers Guild of America.

In 2012, Christina produced the wine documentary "SOMM", a film that followed four men attempting to pass the Master Sommelier exam. After spending time at the top of the i-Tunes chart and becoming a hit on Netflix, Esquire Network developed a reality TV series in the mold of "SOMM" titled "Uncorked." In 2016, the follow up film "SOMM- Into the Bottle" was released worldwide by Samuel Goldwyn Films. Her next feature documentary "Wait For Your Laugh" is slated for a 2017 theatrical release.
